Travel Advice and Vaccination Services

Our nurses, Alison, Becky and Cate are able to provide travel advice and a general travel assessment.

They will also administer those vaccines which are available, without charge, on the NHS. They include:

- Typhoid
- Hepatitis A
- Diphtheria / Tetanus / Polio

We are also able to administer Hepatitis B for travel purposes but this is chargeable. Prices are subject to change and you will be advised of the current fee before attending for your appointment.

We offer appointments for travel vaccinations during normal surgery hours and occasionally when we are open on Saturday mornings.

If you would like telephone advice from one of our nurses prior to arranging your appointment please phone Reception.

All other vaccinations can be provided by Travel Clinics e.g. Boots in Oxford, Manor Hospital Oxford and Abingdon Surgery,

Vaccines available from Private Travel Clinics include:

- Hepatitis B
- Rabies
- T.B.E.(Tick Borne Encephalitis)
- J.E. (Japanese Encephalitis)
- Meningitis ACWY

- Yellow Fever

A fee will be charged by Private Travel Clinics for the consultation and the vaccinations although these rates may vary.

Arranging your Vaccines before Travelling:

To ensure that you allow sufficient time for your immunity to develop before travelling please arrange your consultations at least:

- 1 month before departure for routine trips of 2 – 4 weeks in duration
- 6 - 12 months before departure for world treks.

Anti Malaria Tablets

If anti-malaria tablets are required for your journey, you will be informed during your consultation. Most chemists can supply these without a prescription.

Please note anti-malaria tablets are not available on the NHS and you will be charged the retail price by the pharmacy.
